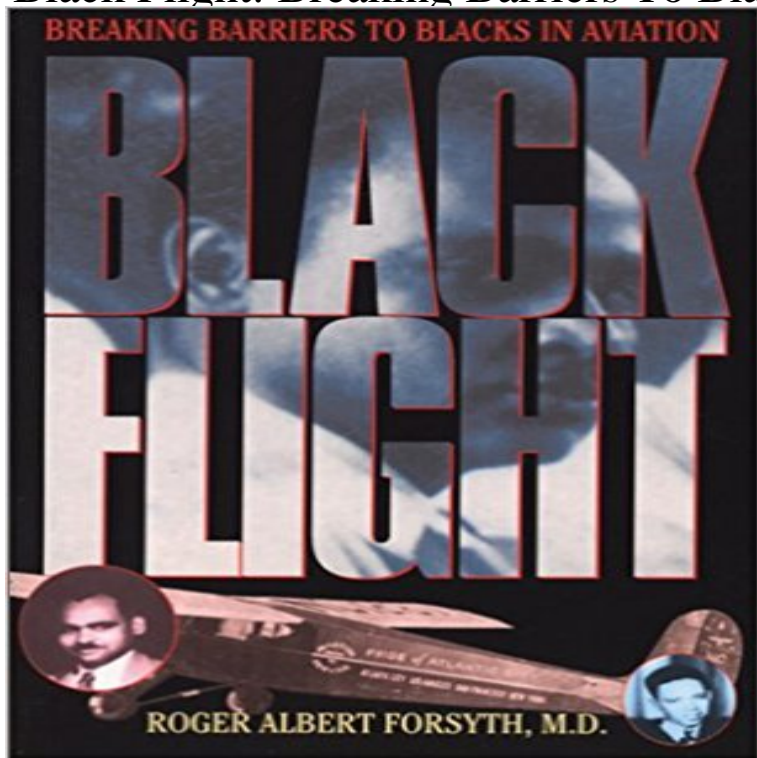


Black Flight: Breaking Barriers To Blacks In Aviation
