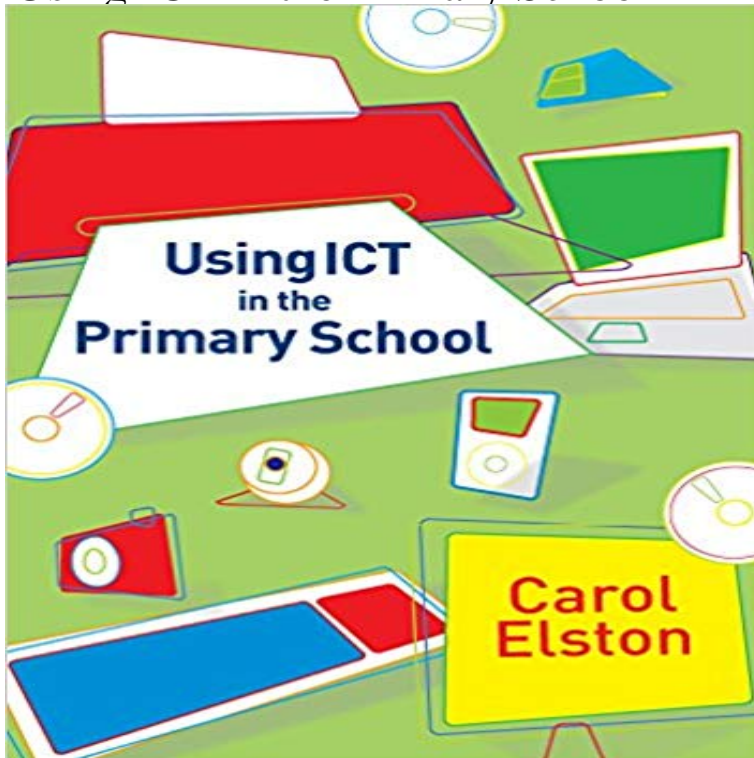


## Using ICT in the Primary School
