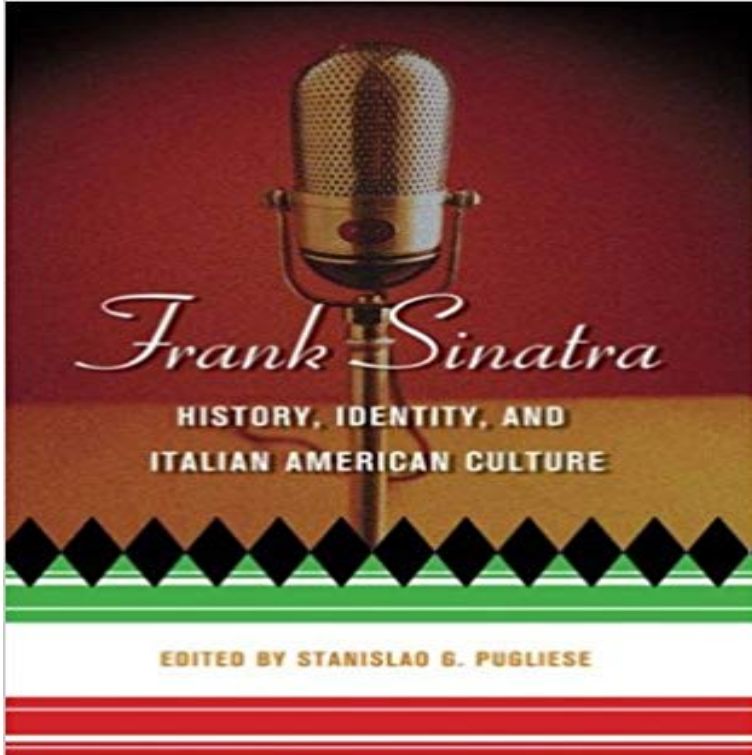


## Frank Sinatra: History, Identity, and Italian American Culture (Italian & Italian American Studies)
