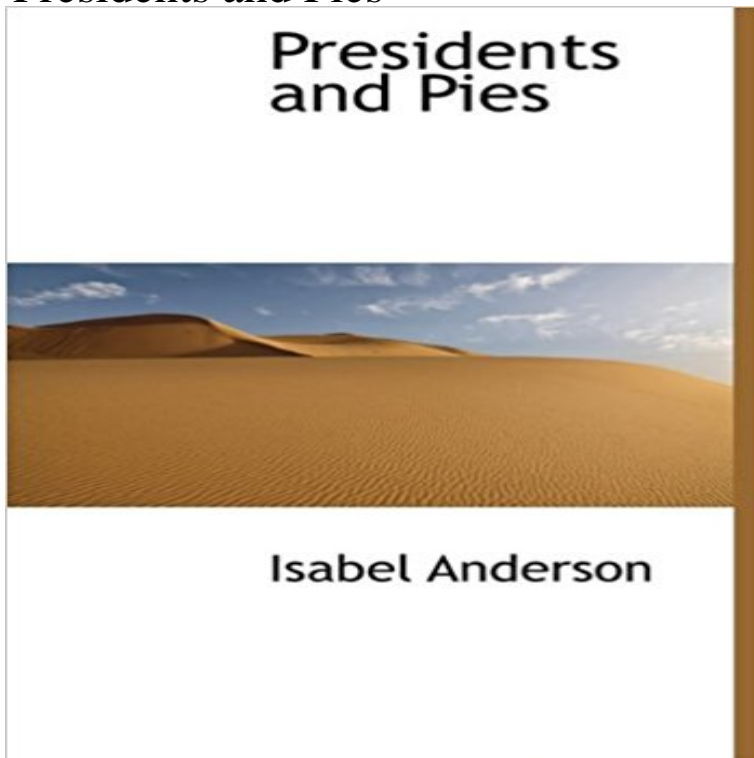


Presidents and Pies
