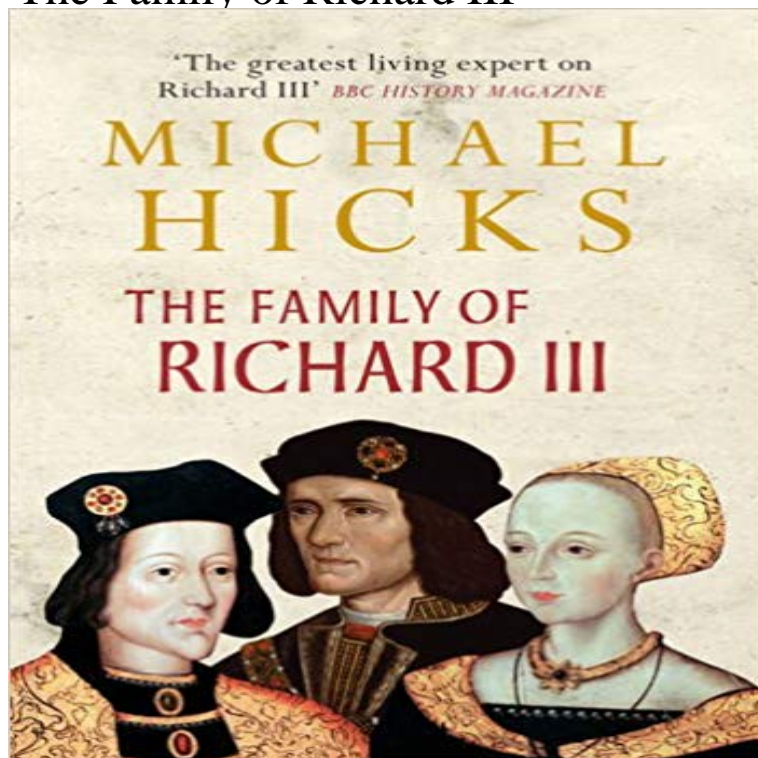


The Family of Richard III



The Wars of the Roses were quarrels within the Plantagenet family, of which Richards dynasty, the House of York, was one branch.
