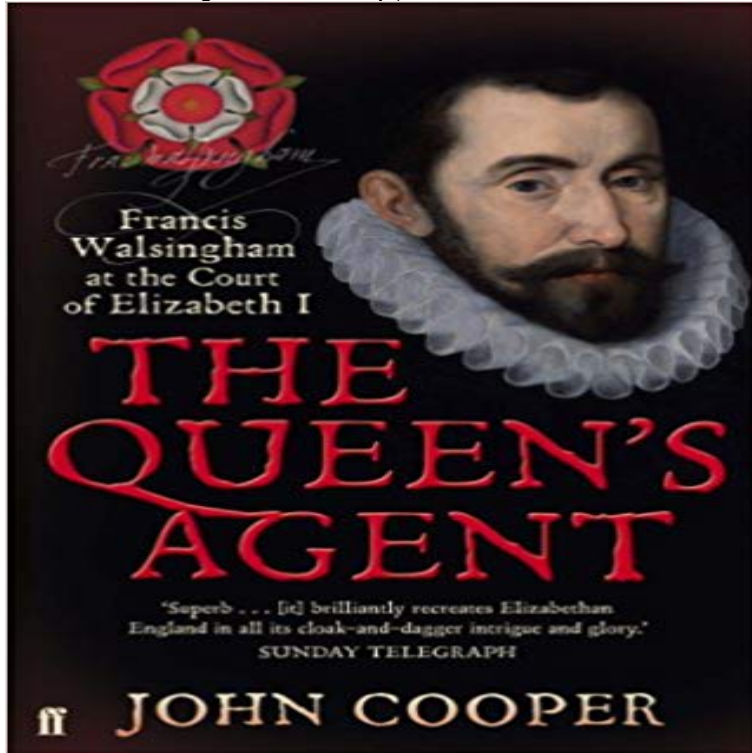


The The Queens Agent: Francis Walsingham at the Court of Elizabeth I
